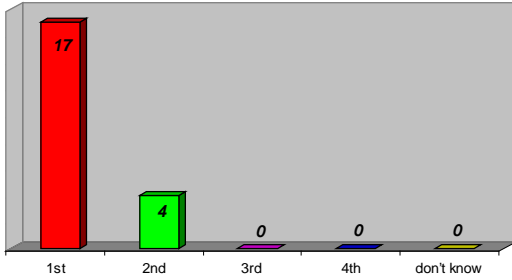

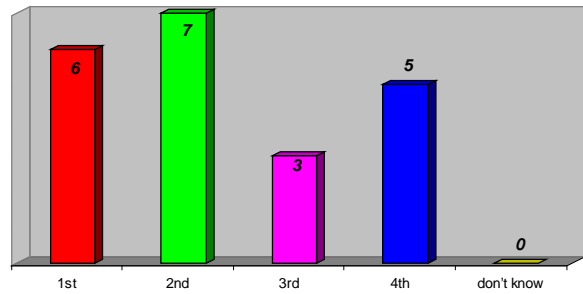
SECTION A GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

Q1 In your opinion, among the expected results below, which are the most important?

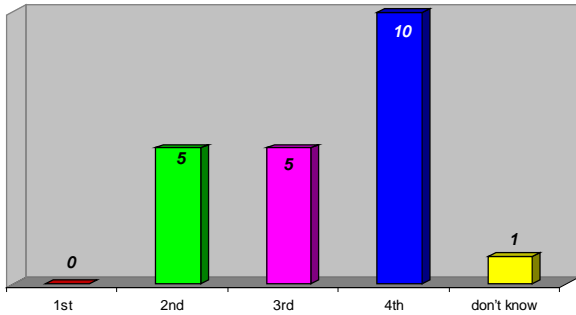
1.1 A methodology and tool (RIAT+) to support local authorities in designing and assessing efficient air quality plans.



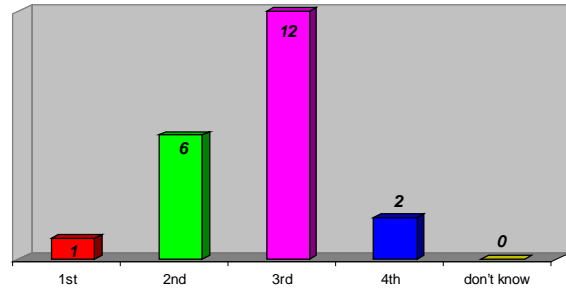

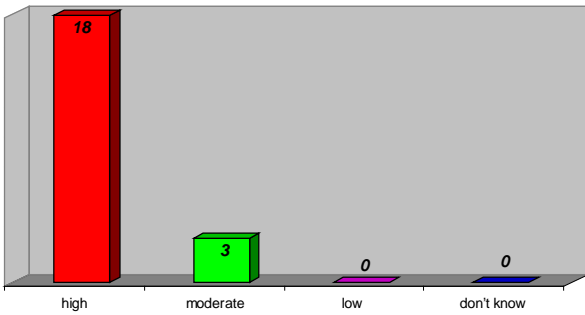
1.3 A full documentation, workshop and courses to support new users implementing the methodology to other European regions.



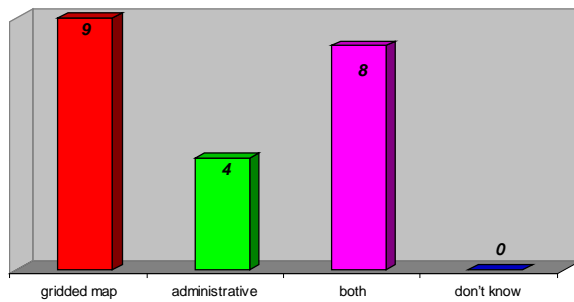
1.4 Guidelines for local administrations and environmental agencies (this is a national priority for Italy) to integrate local planning to national and European air quality policies.
